THE BALLROOM

For smaller occasions, the Ballroom can be divided with a solid oak partition to create two separate rooms: the Crick and the Watson, named after James Watson and Francis Crick who made the groundbreaking discovery, the structure of DNA, 'the secret of life' here in Cambridge in 1953. The sense of elegance without pomposity, of intimacy over corporate formality, is unusual for Cambridge.

Our wine list is as eclectic as the college crests that adorn the stained glass windows and when the sun sets, the chandeliers dim, while the evening continues over candlelight.







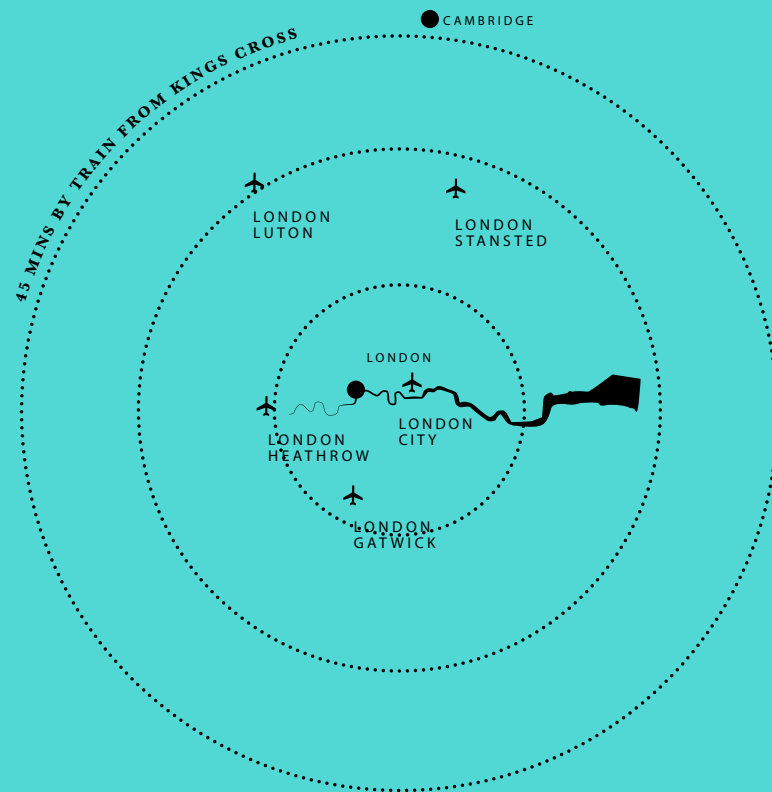
